

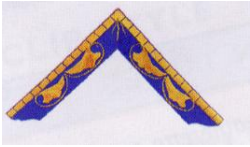

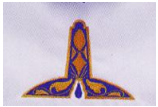

MODERN DAY FREEMASONS WEAR THEIR MASONIC RINGS AS A SYMBOL OF THEIR ONGOING OBLIGATION OF LOYALTY, THEIR BROTHERHOOD AND AS A VISUAL STATEMENT THAT THEY ARE A MEMBER OF THE OLDEST FRATERNITY ON EARTH.

HOW SHOULD MASONS WEAR THEIR RINGS? IF I LAY MY HAND OUT FLAT IN FRONT OF ME, SHOULD THE TWO LEGS OF THE COMPASS POINT TOWARD ME, OR POINT OUTWARD AND AWAY FROM ME? WE MAY WEAR OUR RINGS WITH THE LEGS OF THE COMPASS POINTING TOWARD US, AS SOME SAY, TO HELP US REMEMBER OUR OBLIGATIONS.

THE OTHER POINT OF VIEW, OF COURSE, IS TO WEAR IT OUTWARD TOWARD ALL WHO SEE IT, SHARING THE LIGHT OF MASONRY WITH THE WORLD AND PROCLAIMING OUR MEMBERSHIP IN THE CRAFT.

THE ANSWER? NO GRAND LODGE HAS EVER SPECIFIED THE 'CORRECT' WAY TO WEAR A MASONIC RING, EXCEPT TO WEAR IT WITH PLEASURE TO YOURSELF AND HONOR TO THE FRATERNITY.

I SAT THINKING OF OUR LODGE THE OTHER DAY. WHERE DID IT COME FROM AND WHERE IS IT GOING? WHAT SINCERE MASONS FIRST BEGAN BUILDING OUR TEMPLE IN LAKE ELSINORE IN 1888, AND WHAT OTHER MEN OF LIKE MIND DID THE SAME 22 YEARS LATER IN PERRIS?

YOU CAN IDENTIFY SOME OF THESE LODGE CHARTER MEMBERS AND THEIR SUCCESSORS BY LOOKING AT THE PAST MASTER'S PICTURES ON THE WALLS OF OUR LODGE. BUT THAT IS ONLY SCRATCHING THE SURFACE OF THEIR MASONIC INTENT. DID ANY OF THEM EVER ENVISION WHAT WE HAVE IN MASONRY TODAY IN MENIFEE VALLEY LODGE NO. 289.

I SEE THE LODGE SOMEWHAT LIKE THE "...CERTAIN POINT WITHIN A CIRCLE..." REFERRED TO IN THE MASTER'S LECTURE OF THE ENTERED APPRENTICE DEGREE. WE ARE SURROUNDED BY THE COMMUNITIES OF PERRIS, ROMOLAND, HOMELAND, WINCHESTER, MURRIETA, WILDOMAR, LAKE ELSINORE, CANYON LAKE AND THE CITY OF MENIFEE (QUAIL VALLEY, SUN CITY AND MENIFEE). WE ARE LIKE THE SUN TO THE SOLAR SYSTEM. THE LIGHT OF MASONRY SHINES OUT TO ALL AROUND US. IT HAS CERTAINLY ATTRACTED MEN OF ALL STATIONS AND AGES TO OUR LODGE.

THE YOUNG AGE OF SO MANY OF OUR NEWEST MEMBERS IS THE FULLFILMENT OF THAT PROMISE MADE SO MANY TIMES OVER THE YEARS WHEN MEMBERS WERE FEW AND FAR BETWEEN. 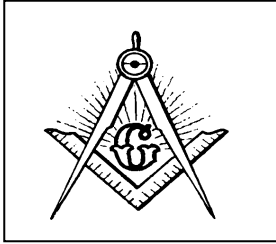
