Legislation : among several simple items that I won't list here , there are a few that should be noted :

1. GM Recommendation to reduce 5/6 to 3/4 for adoption of legislation Failed 87.7% Y 12.3% No
2. Resolution to change required number of members from 25 to 15 to form a new lodge did Pass.
3. Resolution to allow Inspectors a vote at Annual Communication Y60.8% Carry-Over
4. Resolution to allow Past Master's title upon serving a consecutive term Y89.6% Passed
5. Loosening Qualification procedure of Past Masters who come back to serve again had No 62.4%, therefore Failed.
6. Early presentation of Golden Veteran Award up to 6 months prior to actual membership date and anytime the same year for a Diamond Award recipient Passed 92.2% Y
